Albert Schepers of McBain passed away Sunday morning, February 10, 2013 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 93. He was born March 9, 1919 in Lucas to Gilbert and Hattie (Ostendie) Schepers.

Mr. Schepers served in the United States Army during World War II. After the war he worked on the Ann Arbor Railroad for over 30 years. He served on the McBain Fire Department for 42 years.
