Aleeta Houghtaling Hewitt of Burton, West Virginia formerly of Cadillac passed away Thursday, December 11, 2014 at her home in Burton. She was 96.

She was born on August 9, 1918 in Meauwataka, Michigan to Edward L. & Elizabeth M. (Babenroth) Houghtaling. On June 2, 1940 in Meauwataka she married Lloyd R. Hewitt and he preceded her in death on April 7, 2010.

Aleeta attended Manton High School, Wexford County Normal graduating in 1937. She later graduated from Western Michigan University in 1964 with a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education. She enjoyed gardening, crafts and working with 4-H clubs for several years. Mrs. Hewitt enjoyed spending 24 winters in Zephyrhills, Florida.
