Amelia Rose Benson, life long resident of Cadillac, went home to be with the Lord on February 9, 2011. She was 77.

She was born on April 7, 1933 to Edville and Permelia (Nichols) Carlson. Amelia graduated from Cadillac High School in 1951. She then married Robert K. Benson on June 16, 1951 and worked along side him running the family farm.

In addition to farming and raising six children, Amelia served as Clam Lake Twp. Clerk for eight years and did volunteer work for various organizations, including: Michigan Farm Bureau where she also served on the State Women's Committee; American Red Cross; Love INC; and DHS.
