Audreen Ann Tripp of Cadillac passed away Monday morning, September 2, 2024 at her home. She was 91. Audreen was born on July 9, 1933 in Houghton, Iowa to Robert & Rose (Benjamin) Cooper.

Audreen moved to Cadillac in 1971 where she began working at the Cadillac Evening News. She then was employed at Blick Dillon Insurance for 23 years before retiring in 1998. Audreen was a long time member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac as well as a choir member.

She loved going to the beach and reading. Audreen enjoyed crocheting, knitting and cross stitch. She was known for matching her outfits with her twin. Most of all Audreen loved her family and her greatest joys were all her grandchildren.

She is survived by her children: John (Cristie) Tripp, Robert Tripp, Carol (Craig) Thompson all of Cadillac, Linda (Terry) Bronkema of Lucas, Julie (Joe) LaPan of Manton, David (Reva) Tripp of Denton, Texas; 19 grandchildren; 35 great-grandchildren; five great great grandchildren and her twin, Colleen Farrell- Vliet of Cadillac.

On February 5, 1956 in Fort Madison, Iowa she married Jerry Leroy Tripp and he preceded her in death on January 15, 2007. In addition to her husband

Audreen was preceded in death by a great grandson, Joseph Bates on January 18, 2000 and 11 siblings.

A memorial mass will be held 11:00 AM Monday, September 9, 2024 at St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac with Fr. Kunal Baliarsingh as celebrant. Friends may meet the family prior to mass at church. Her final resting place will be Mount Carmel Cemetery in Cadillac.

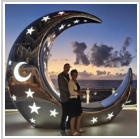
