



## Beatrice E. Gregg

July 19, 1924 - January 18, 2019

Beatrice E. Gregg of Cadillac passed away Friday morning, January 18, 2019 at Sunnyside Senior Living in Cadillac. She was 94. Beatrice was born on July 19, 1924 in Cadillac to Emil & Jennie (Beckstrom) Norman.

Mrs. Gregg had lived all her life in the Tustin & Cadillac areas and was a graduate of Tustin High School. In August of 1944 Bea and her lifelong friend, Jeanette Campbell traveled to New London, Connecticut where Beatrice married her high school sweetheart Bruce Gregg, who was stationed at the New London Naval Base. They were married on August 30, 1944 and he preceded her in death on March 7, 2006.
