Beverly Ann Johnson of Tustin passed away, Wednesday, October 17, 2018 at Carondelet St. Joseph's Hospital in Tucson, Arizona. She was 87.

Beverly was born July 30, 1931 in Tustin, Michigan to Gordon W. and Marion L. (Anderson) Huffman and they preceded her in death.

Beverly graduated from Central Michigan University and went on to have a 34- year teaching career. Throughout her career Mrs. Johnson taught in Mt. Morris, Flint and retired from Cadillac Area Public Schools. While teaching Mrs. Johnson taught junior high and high schools; primarily home economics.

She was a long- time member of Augustana Lutheran Church of Tustin.

On September 8, 1951 at Augustana Lutheran Church she married Donald H.
