Brian John Miller of Cadillac passed away suddenly Saturday morning, June 22, 2013 at his home. He was 53. He was born on January 6, 1960 in Lansing to Robert John & Elaine (Egolf) Miller and they preceded him in death.

Brian graduated from Pewamo-Westphalia High School in 1978 and went on to receive his Associate's degree in computer science from Lansing Community College. He was employed at Paul Automotive in Lansing for 8 years and in 1988 he moved to Cadillac and had been employed as the manager for Road Equipment.

Brian enjoyed fishing and was involved in many Bass Clubs throughout the area. He also enjoyed traveling, bowling, NASCAR, the Detroit Tigers, Red Wings and Lions, as well as hunting and was an avid outdoorsman. parents he was preceded in death by his father-in-law, Gordon Dunseth.
