



## Carlton D. Sarver

September 2, 1936 - November 2, 2015

Carlton D. "Fuzzy" Sarver of Tustin passed away suddenly Monday afternoon, November 2, 2015 at his home. He was 79. He was born on September 2, 1936 in Luther to Carlton L. & Lois M. (Wilder) Sarver and they preceded him in death.

Carl graduated from Luther High School as the Valedictorian of his class. On October 26, 1957 he married the former Iris R. Sims and she preceded him in death on August 27, 1997.
