Carol Louise Dumond of Cadillac went to be with her Lord Friday evening, July 4, 2025 at her home. She was 74. Carol was born on June 7, 1951 in Marion, Indiana to Phillip L. & Virginia M. (Dowling) Johnson.

In 1964 Carol moved to Owosso, Michigan and graduated from Owosso High School in 1969, where she met the love of her life Allen. While in Owosso she had been employed at Voights Drugstore. On June 15, 1974 at the First Christian Church in Owosso she married Allen R. Dumond and they lived in Owosso until 1978 when they moved to Cadillac.

In Cadillac Carol worked at the Mitchell Corporation and at Mercy Hospital as an X-Ray Assistant. She was a member of First Baptist Church in Cadillac and she sang in the choir and was a Sunday school teacher. Carol was a Brownie leader. She enjoyed quilting and made lots of beautiful quilts, sewing and made clothes for her daughters when they were young, she loved Christmas and decorating for the holiday, she also loved shopping with her girls, going on trips, and Mackinac Islands was her favorite place to vacation. Carol and Al spent their 50th wedding anniversary on Mackinac Island last June.

Carol loved her family more than anything. She enjoyed making dinners and having her family over. Her 3 dogs: Molly, Millie, and Meghan were very

precious to her. Carol was very loving, always giving hugs and was beautiful inside and out. She was proud of her 1970 Plymouth Duster and she saw Elvis in Concert at the Silverdome in 1974.

Survivors include her husband of 51 years Allen "Al" Dumond along with their 2 daughters: Alanna "Laney" Dumond and Katy (Harold) Danford all of Cadillac; and her grandson, Landyn Danford who was the light of her life and she loved spending time with him. In addition to her parents Carol was preceded in death by a brother, Jay L. Johnson in 2017.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 AM Thursday, July 10, 2025 at First Baptist Church in Cadillac with Pastor Chad Zaucha and Pastor Dave McMahon officiating.
