Carolyn Louise Lucas of Cadillac passed away November 2, 2025 at home surrounded by her family. She was 80. Carolyn was born August 12, 1945 of Cadillac, Michigan to Richard and Mary Lou (Butcher) Watson and they preceded her in death.

Carolyn graduated from Cadillac High School in 1963. She loved music and had spent part of her summer at Interlochen Center for the Arts. That love of music led her and her husband, Dick, to open Northern Music Supply and for Carolyn to teach piano lessons for 13 years. The couple then purchased Cadillac Square Marina; after the sale of the marina Carolyn began working at Turtle Creek Casino. In 2008 with her husband, they planted their legacy for future generations in Double L Blueberry Farm. While running the blueberry farm Carolyn played piano and organ in area churches for many years, lastly at Zion Lutheran Church. She was also an avid knitter; knitting baby hats for the hospital, mittens for the mitten tree and sweaters and blankets for her family.

On June 6, 1964 at St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac she married Richard A. "Dick" Lucas and he survives her along with their children: Rebecca (Derek) Larrance and Deborah (Todd) Jiskra; grandchildren: Mackenzie (Chandler) Gabara, Corbin Larrance, Marie Ulrich, Christopher (Heather) Ulrich and great-granddaughter, Louella Gabara.

The Mass of Christian Burial will be held 11:00 AM Friday, November 7, 2025 at St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac with Reverend Fr. Michael Janowski as celebrant.
