Cecelia M. Stoll of Tustin passed away Monday, September 9, 2013 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. She was 90. She was born on November 7, 1922 in Chicago to Michael Josef & Katherine P. (Wrobel) Syzdek and they preceded her in death.

Cecelia graduated from high school in Detroit and then went into the United States Navy and served for 3 years during World War II. It was during that time that she met her husband, Willard Lewis Stoll and they were married on May 3, 1945 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and he preceded her in death on Sept. 13, 1993.

After the War she went on to the University of Detroit and received her Bachelor's degree and later she received her Master's degree from Wayne State University.
