Charles E. Carlson of Cadillac passed away Thursday, September 13, 2018 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. He was 88. Charles was born on June 8, 1930 in Cadillac to Edville E. & Permelia Z. (Nichols) Carlson. On June 10, 1950 in Cadillac he married the former Bonnie Forquer and she preceded him in death on October 28, 1998.

Charles graduated from Cadillac High School and went on to serve his country in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. Upon returning from the war he went to work at Kellogg's in Battle Creek and retired from there after many years of service.

Mr. Carlson was a member of the AMVETS Post 110 of Cadillac and the American Legion Post 94 of Cadillac. In his younger years he was an avid bowler and had accomplished a perfect game of 300. He also enjoyed deer hunting, bird hunting and fishing.

Survivors include his son, Charles Carlson of Cadillac; a sister, Estella Gorham of Battle Creek and 13 nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents and his wife he was preceded in death by a brother, Edville Carlson and 2 sisters: Mary Carlson and Amelia Benson and his loving companion, Katie Davis.

Funeral services will be 11:00 AM Tuesday, September 18, 2018 at Peterson Funeral & Cremation Services in Cadillac with Pastor Jim Helmboldt officiating.
