



## Clarence D. "Pudge" Fauble

November 23, 1940 - September 15, 2017

Clarence Dean "Pudge" Fauble of Cadillac passed away Friday, September 15, 2017 at his home surrounded by family and lifetime friends. He was 76. Pudge was born November 23, 1940 in Dighton, Michigan to John Henry and Ethel May (Fewless) Fauble.

He attended Dighton and Tustin Schools and as a child attended Wesleyan Methodist Church in Dighton. When his children were young the family attended Independent Bible Church in Cadillac. Pudge was currently affiliated with Cadillac First Church of the Nazarene.

Pudge was a compassionate man; always helping and putting others before himself. His favorite meal of the day was always breakfast. He loved to do yardwork and enjoyed riding on his lawnmower and snow blower. Pudge was a devoted husband, father and grandfather and took time to coach his children and grandchildren's sports teams. He personally enjoyed sports as well, playing fast pitch softball, basketball and bowling. He loved to go for rides around the lake and taking trips to visit family out of town. Pudge's love for Pepsi and his parakeet Tweety will be fondly remembered by those who knew him.

He worked for Armstrong Chevrolet in the 1960's, which went well with his love for classic cars, especially his 1972 Chevy Impala convertible. Pudge retired from Avon, formerly known as Cadillac Rubber and Plastics after 40 years.
