Cullann E. Roose of Cadillac went to be with her Lord Monday, July 21, 2025 at Sunnyside Assisted Living in Cadillac. She was 82. She was born on June 14, 1943 in Peoria, Illinois to Cully & Mary (Petefish) Parsons.

Cullann was raised in Peoria and attended a Christian grade school there and graduated from Mount Carmel High School in Vanclave, Kentucky in 1961. In 1964 she graduated from Kentucky Mountain Bible College where she met her husband Dave and they were married on June 20, 1964. She served Wesleyan Churches with him for 14 years and at Temple Hill Baptist Church in Cadillac from 1999-2007.

She went on to receive a Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Marion University in Marion, Indiana. Cullann sub-taught in the Cadillac Public Schools for several years before teaching at Heritage Christian School in Cadillac for 17 years.

Cullann was a member of Temple Hill Baptist Church since 1978 and had served as the church secretary for 7 years under Rev. Arnold Olson and was on the C.E. Board for many years. She taught some children's classes and for several years she taught a Ladies Bible class at THBC. Cullann also played the piano and sang in the Ladies Trio and duets with her husband and was a great harmony singer.

She loved to travel with her husband, Dave. They saw the four corners of the United States and parts of Canada in tents and RV's. She also enjoyed camping with family and friends especially in her 5th wheel RV.

Cullann was a cancer survivor since 1995 and she truly gave her heart and life to Jesus Christ as an adult and testifies to her hope in Heaven. Rom 15:13.

Survivors include her husband, Dave Roose of Cadillac and their son, Paul (Jenna) Roose of McAllister, Montana; 5 grandchildren: Brittane E. (Chad) Beerens, Triston A. (Rebekah) Wilson, Hannah N. Roose, Isabella E. Roose, and Zinna E. Roose; 5 great grandchildren: Layne, Aubree, Bradey and Lucas Beerens and Dan Wilson; her sister, Nancy (John) Harding; and many nieces, nephews and cousins.

In addition to her parents Cullann was preceded in death by a daughter, Nancee E. Wilson in 2017.
