Daniel John "Dan" Wiese of Cadillac passed away unexpectedly Monday, September 22, 2014 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 63. Dan was born May 30, 1951 in Saginaw to Robert V. and Helen J. (Schultz) Wiese.

Dan graduated from Reese High School and worked at General Motors for 26 years before retiring from there. He was a member of Cherry Grove Church of the Nazarene.
