David Richard Kinter of Cadillac (Formerly of Waterford, MI) went to be with his Lord Thursday, September 20, 2018 at the Curry House Assisted Living in Cadillac. David was born on January 1, 1927 in Detroit to Walter & Ivy Kinter, who preceded him in death. He was 91 years old.

He graduated from Clarkston High School and lived in the Waterford area most of his life, moving to Cadillac in 2015. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII. Mr. Kinter worked at General Motors, Truck and Coach Division, Pontiac, MI, as an inspector for 30 years, retiring in 1977.

On February 14, 1953, he married Pearl Marie Thomas and she preceded him in death in 2001. He then married Gladys Finch in 2002 and she preceded him in death in 2003.
