David Packer of Orrington, Maine formerly of Cadillac and Boon passed away Thursday morning October 2, 2014 in Maine. He was 97.

He was born September 1, 1917 in Yale, Michigan to Fred and Jean (Keniburg) Packer and they preceded him in death. On June 19, 1948 he married the former Thelma Brown and she preceded him in death on January 25, 1991. He then married the former Rose (Freeman) Baldinus on November 9, 1991 and she preceded him in death on November 21, 2008.

Dave attended Flint Northern School before moving to Boon in 1945. He had served in the United States Army as a technical Fifth Grade 25th Base Post Office in Wersburg, Germany. Dave farmed in the Boon area and worked at Kysor in Cadillac for 22 years until retiring as the Manager of the Wexford Community Credit Union in 1980. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, photography and bird watching.

He survived by his children: Patricia Wallin of Cadillac, Jerry (Marsha) Packer of Dixon, Missouri, Reverend Daniel (Debora) Packer of Orrington, Maine, Darwin Packer of Boon; 17 grandchildren; 29 great grandchildren and one great- great grandchild.

In addition to his parents and his two spouses he was preceded in death by a

grandson, David O. Packer, a sister, Doris and a son in law, Fred Wallin.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 AM Wednesday, October 8, 2014 at the Peterson Funeral Home in Cadillac with Reverend Daniel Packer officiating.
