David Herman Radtke of Cadillac passed away Saturday, January 6, 2024 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. He was 90. David was born January 19, 1933 in Detroit, Michigan.

He served in the United States Navy and later moved to the Cadillac area. Dave worked Cadillac Molded Rubber, which was later known as Paulstra for 30 years before retiring. He then worked at Speedway for 20 years.
