Delbert J. Packard, Jr. of Grand Haven formerly of Cadillac passed away Monday, July 25, 2016 at Robbinswood Assisted Living in Grand Haven. He was 93.

Delbert was born on January 24, 1923 in Ann Arbor, Michigan to Delbert J. & Irma (Noggle) Packard, Sr. He married the former Bethel M. Stolt on July 23, 1977 and she preceded him in passing in 1990.

Mr. Packard graduated from Ann Arbor High School in 1941 and attended Cleary College in Ypsilanti and graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.
