Donald W. Fagerman of Cadillac passed away Saturday morning, April 9, 2016 at his home with his family at his side. He was 71. He was born on May 1, 1944 in Detroit to Milborn O. & Gladys E. (Peterson) Fagerman and they preceded him in death.

Don lived most of his life in Cadillac and graduated from Cadillac High School in 1962. He had been employed at the Truck & Bus Division of General Motors in Flint for 30 years and retired in 1994.
