Doris attended Milan Schools from K-12. After graduation she attended Henry Ford Training School. During World War II she worked in the secretarial pool at Holly Carburetor in Detroit. The “girls” she worked with there became lifelong friends.

At war’s end Doris returned to Milan and in 1949 married Milan’s most sought after bachelor, George Falk. They built a house on East Main Street and Doris lived there for over 30 years. George preceded her in death in 1982. George and Doris had two daughters, Denise and Marie. Marie preceded her mother in death 2020.
