Ellen Wilson of Cadillac went to be with her Lord Thursday evening, February 15, 2018 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. She was 90. Ellen was born on October 25, 1927 to Albert & Beatrice (Hammond) VanBuskirk in Ann Arbor, Michigan. On March 13, 1948 in Cadillac she married Frank E. Wilson and he preceded her in death on February 19, 1999.

Ellen graduated from Cadillac High School in 1945 and attended Marion College, now known as Indiana Wesleyan University in Marion, Indiana for a couple of years.

Mrs. Wilson was a member of Temple Hill Baptist Church in Cadillac and had served as the organist and was on the music committee. She was a longtime member and former president of the Christian Women's Club in Cadillac. Her passion for music has been handed down to her family and to the many students that took lessons from her over the years.

Survivors include her four sons: Marvin Wilson of Frankenmuth, Michigan, Daryl (Cecilia) Wilson of Dallas, Texas, Kevin Wilson and Dana Wilson both of Cadillac; 9 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held 11:00 AM Friday, February 23, 2018 at Temple Hill Baptist Church in Cadillac with Reverend Jack Miller officiating.
