Estle R. D. Engle, Jr. of Leroy passed away early Wednesday morning, August 12, 2015 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. He was 69. \n\nHe was born on October 9, 1945 in Hastings, Michigan to Estle R.D. & Genevieve J. (Keller) Engle and they preceded him in death.\n\nR.D. graduated from Newberry High School in 1965 and was later drafted in the United States Army and served 3 tours during the Vietnam era. After the war he came home and served 2 years in the United States Naval Reserves. R.D. then attended Southwestern Technical Institute in North Carolina and graduated with Associates degrees in Business Administration and Early Childhood Development.\n\nMr. Engle was a faithful member of Zion Lutheran Church in Leroy and had also served as Sec/Treasurer there and of Augustana Lutheran Church in Tustin. He also worked for Big Brothers Big Sisters and the DNR as well as being a stay at home father for some time. R.D. loved reading his Bible every day, watching the weather channel, the Upper Peninsula, the Mackinaw Bridge, and clocks & watches. Mr. Engle was also a member of the Disabled American Veterans.\n\nOn February 14, 1981 in Lake County, Michigan he married the former Lois M. Corson and she survives him along with their daughter, Genevieve Engle and grandson, Isaac Engle all of Leroy; 2 brothers: Henry Engle of Evart and Timothy (Tina) Engle of Illinois; 1 niece and 1 nephew.\n\nMemorial services will be held 11:00 AM Tuesday, August 18, 2015 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Leroy with Pastor Michael Holman, S.A.M. officiating.
