Eunice Anne “Angie” Ghent (Crabtree), born in England in 1936, passed away on 01/02/2026.

Eunice experienced WWII in London with her parents Hilda and Tom Crabtree. Her parents immigrated to America when she was 12 yrs. old. In 1954, she met Harry Allen Ghent in Lincoln, Nebraska where he was serving in the Air Force. They lived a rich life together, celebrating their 70th anniversary and renewing their vows at Edgett’s Wesleyan Church in Luther, Michigan.

After their children were grown, Eunice completed her educational program at Baker College in Cadillac. She retired from the State of Michigan in the early 2000s. She and Harry enjoyed life in Michigan while also traveling as “snowbirds” in their RV. Everyone who met Eunice remembers her welcoming radiant smile and laughter. She authored a book, *Through It All*, to share her story about her love of family and how faith helped her through tragedy and trials. She taught Sunday School at Edgett’s Wesleyan Church and also authored *The PS Book*, with resources for plays and activities.

Eunice was preceded in death by her beloved husband Harry and two children Joyce Anne and Lois Marie. She is survived by children Edith, Beverley, Donald, and Anthony; grandchildren Shawn, Chelsea, Rachel, Michaela, and

Katie; great grandchildren Connor, Carson, Carter, and Beau.
