Evelyn M. Lund of Cadillac died Thursday afternoon, October 20, 2011 at Autumnwood of McBain. She was 91. She was born in Cadillac on September 15, 1920 to Clinton E. & Effie V. (Peterson) Pettengill. Evelyn had lived all her life in Cadillac and graduated from Cadillac High School in 1938. On April 12, 1941 in Cadillac she married Walter "Gil" Lund and he preceded her in death on July 16, 2009.

She had been employed at the Dental Offices of Dr. Westman, Dr. Mossberg and Dr. Moriarity in Cadillac.
