November 3, 1921 - December 28, 2015

Frank Zinger of Mesick went to be with his Lord Monday, December 28, 2015 at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City. He was 94. He was born on November 3, 1921 in McBain to John & Josie (Hoffstra) Zinger.

Frank attended school in McBain and later went into the United States Army during World War II serving in the Battle of the Bulge. After the service he went to work in Grand Rapids, Michigan for a short time and later moved back to the Marion area to raise beef cattle on the family farm and to own & operate Zinger Heating & Cooling until he retired. Mr. Zinger loved trapping, hunting, reading, walking, watching Fox News, and was known as a very conservative man.

He was a member of Faith Reformed Church in Traverse City and also attended the First Church of the Nazarene in Cadillac, First Baptist Church in Cadillac, and loved watching Billy Graham.

On January 3, 1974 in Cadillac he married the former Elaine J. Langworthy and she survives him along with his children: Rev. James (Marilyn) Zinger of Hudsonville, Robert (Tami) Zinger of Marion, Judy (Curt) Hannon of Fostoria, MI, Jack (Connie) Zinger of Comstock Park, and Debra Els of Big Rapids; 16 grandchildren; 25 great grandchildren; step-children: Lori (Bruce) Jewett of Jasper, MI, Darrin Oudman of Mesick, Sandra (Tim) Brown of Gaylord and Dawn (Ron) Jacobs of Cadillac; 8 step-grandchildren; 2 step great
