



## Fred C. Wallin

December 9, 1938 - February 9, 2013

Fred C. Wallin of Cadillac passed away Saturday afternoon, February 9, 2013 at Spectrum Health Butterworth Campus in Grand Rapids. He was 74. He was born on December 9, 1938 in Cadillac to Donald F. & Durah T. (Roberts) Wallin and they preceded him in death.

Fred graduated from Cadillac High School and served in the United States Air Force until November of 1957. He had been employed at CMI for 15 years and was the owner/operator of Wallin Farms in Meauwataka for 37 years. Fred was a member of the Cadillac Elks Lodge #680.

On April 16, 1957 in London, England he married the former Patricia J. Packer and she survives him along with their children: Fred (Sally) Wallin, Jr., Marcy (Jim) Manser, and John (Beth) Wallin; 3 grandchildren: Fred Wallin, III, Tom Wallin and Jenica Wallin all of Cadillac; a sister, JoAnn (Laddy) Forrester of Huntington, IN; and father-in-law, David Packer of Cadillac. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a brother, Jack Wallin and step-father, Fred Brower.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 AM Thursday, February 14, 2013 at the Peterson Funeral Home in Cadillac with Reverend Paul Tomlinson officiating. Burial will be at the Meauwataka Cemetery in Colfax Township, Wexford County. Friends may meet the family from 5-7 PM Wednesday at the Funeral
