Frederick Augustus Lemmon of Tustin passed away Friday, January 24, 2020 at his home. He was 90. Frederick was born March 26, 1929 in Northville, Michigan to Seth & Mae (Lumbert) Lemmon.

Mr. Lemmon attended school in Northville and later served in the United States Army for 3 years. After his service to our country he was employed at Pine Lumber in Northville for a short time before working at Detroit Edison for over 30 years.
