George Andrew Frid of Cadillac passed away unexpectedly Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City. He was 48. George was born on May 22, 1970 in Grants Pass, Oregon to Ross S. & Dorothy L. (Stillman) Frid.

George lived in Oregon for the first 7 years of his life and moved to Cadillac in 1977. He graduated from Cadillac High School in 1989 and later entered the United States Navy and served 2 years as a submariner on the USS Hammerhead during Desert Storm. Upon returning from his service to our country he worked a various delivery jobs in the Cadillac area and had been employed at FED EX for over 10 years.

George was a huge NASCAR fan and attended races at M.I.S. and Bristol with several of his friends. He also enjoyed sports of all kinds and was a Detroit Tiger fan, and a Syracuse football and basketball fan.

George was a Life Member of the NRA and a member of Evergreen Baptist Church and participated in Sunday Funday. He will be remembered for his great sense of humor and his great hugs.
