Glen Albert Coger of Mesick passed away on March 18, 2026 at home. He was 91. Glen was born July 28, 1934 on the family farm in Sherman, Michigan to James LeRoy and Maude (Clark) Coger.

Glen graduated from Mesick High School in 1953 and served in the United States Army. He drove semi and operated heavy equipment, but his true passion was being a dairy farmer on his family's centennial farm. He was a life member of the Amvets Post 120 of Mesick and held most local and district offices throughout his involvement there.

He loved sports and loved supporting his children and grandchildren at their sporting and band events over the years. Glen also volunteered as a bus driver for the Scottville Clown Band.

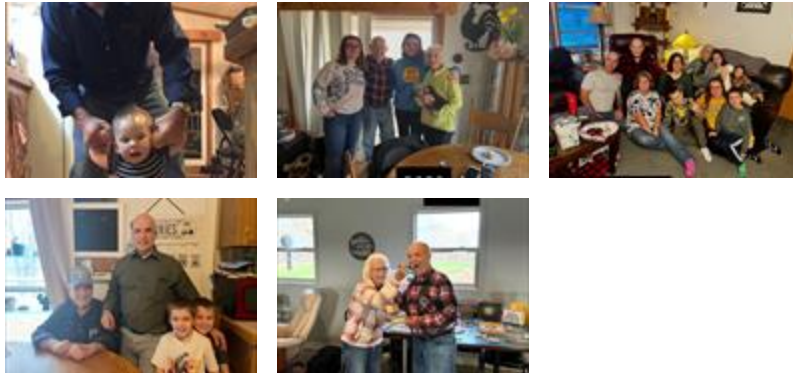
