March 25, 1931 - December 6, 2016

Glenn E. Brooks of Cadillac passed away Tuesday, December 6, 2016 at his home. He was 85.

Mr. Brooks was born March 25, 1931 in Grand Rapids, Michigan to Ralph and Agnes (Cook) Brooks and they preceded him in death. On May 13, 1961 in Grand Rapids he married the former Mary Rita Sobleski and she preceded him in death on December 18, 2010.

He graduated from Catholic High School in Grand Rapids and then went into the National Guard and the United States Air Force for 5 years during the Korean War. Upon returning from the service he went to the University of Michigan and graduated with Bachelor's Degree and was employed there for a few years after graduation.

Mr. Brooks was a Federal Agent for the United States Department of Treasury for 30 years before retiring in 1991. He was a former member of the Clam Lake Masonic Lodge. Mr. Brooks enjoyed hunting, watching movies and spending time with his grandchildren.

He is survived by a son, Robert Brooks of Meauwataka and a daughter, Susan (Audley) Neil of Cadillac; grandchildren, Ryan Massey, Jason (Kelly) Massey, Hunter Ratcliff, Adellah Neil and Elizabeth Neil.

In addition to his parents and wife he was preceded in death by a daughter, Kathy Ratcliff in 1996; a grandson, Justin Ratcliff and many brothers and sisters.
