



## Herbert A. Augustat

May 22, 1934 - March 14, 2024

Herbert Adolph Augustat of Tustin passed away Thursday evening, March 14, 2024 at Sunnyside Senior Living in Cadillac. He was 89. Herb was born on May 22, 1934 in Cadillac to Frederick A. & Florence M. (Brehm) Augustat. On July 19, 1963 he married the former Bonnie DeBoise and she preceded him in death in 2008.

Herb graduated from Pine River High School and went on to attend Michigan State University before entering the United States Air Force serving during the Korean Conflict. After his honorable discharge in 1956 he returned to the area and started his career at Pell's Radio Center where he was employed for 41 years.

He was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene in Cadillac; American Legion Post 94 of Cadillac and the Moose Lodge in Florida. Herb had many hobbies including: fishing, hunting, golfing, bowling, games with family, but one of his greatest joys was spending time with his grandchildren and going to any sporting event or activity they had.

On November 6, 2011 in Cadillac he married Connie L. Mercer and she survives him along with his children: Steven (Becky) Augustat of Cadillac, Lorrie (Jimmie) Hall of Florida, Susan Straight (Chuck Helmka) of Cadillac,

and Alyson "Ellie" (John) Lamphere of Cadillac; several grandchildren and great grandchildren; 2 brothers: Harold (Lois) Augustat of Florida and Walt (LaVonne) Augustat of Lansing; and many nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents and his wife, Bonnie, Herb was preceded in death by a daughter, Barbara Augustat, a son, Anthony Alcorn and 2 brothers, Jimmy and Jerry Augustat.

Memorial services will be held 12 Noon Saturday, March 23, 2024 at the First Church of the Nazarene with Pastor Gil Thibault officiating and military rites under the auspices of the Cadillac Area Honor Guard. Visitation will be from 11:00 AM until services at church. Herb's final resting place will be Sherman Township Cemetery in Osceola County.
