



Hubert M. Krantz

Hubert M. Krantz of Leroy passed away Wednesday morning, October 23, 2013 at his home. He was 83. He was born on February 25, 1930 in Goodlettsville, Tennessee to Hubert & Lena (Utley) Krantz and they preceded him in death.

Mr. Krantz served in the United States Army for eight years during the Korean War. He worked at A & P Jane Parker Bakery in Detroit for 20 years before working 11 years for General Motors at the Cadillac plant in Detroit and retired in 1989. After his retirement he went to work at Dick Genthe Dealership in Southgate. He moved to Leroy in 2000. Mr. Krantz was a member of the Dighton Wesleyan Church and the VFW of Allen Park. He loved hunting.

On August 21, 1964 in Taylor, Michigan he married the former Janie M. Beamon and she survives him along with their children, Gary (Natalie) Krantz of Leroy and Lisa DeCouteau of Dearborn Heights, Michigan; grandchildren: Adam DeCouteau, Dillon DeCouteau, Haliey Krantz and Connor Krantz and a sister, Mae Edwards of Goodlettsville, Tennessee.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother and three sisters.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 a.m. Friday, October 25, 2013 at the Dighton Wesleyan Church with Reverend Derek Carpenter officiating and full military rites under the auspices of the Cadillac Area Honor Guard. Friends
