Ila Mae Gouldman of Boon passed away Sunday morning, June 22, 2025 at her home. She was 91. Ila was born on June 30, 1933 in Manton to Wilmer L. & H. Esther (Burnham) Bailey. On February 4, 1956 she married Harry DeView and he preceded her in death on March 23, 1990.
