Isaiah C. "Ike" Walters of Cadillac passed away Saturday, April 7, 2012 at the home of his son and daughter in law. He was 97.

He was born on August 16, 1914 in Barryton, Michigan to Andrew I. & Mary W. (Wynn) Walters. He married the former Maude Smith on August 22, 1938 in Cadillac and she preceded him in death on April 18, 1993.
