Jack Christopher Foucart of Cadillac died Sunday afternoon, October 2, 2011 at Spectrum Health Butterworth Campus in Grand Rapids. He was 21. Jack was born in Grand Rapids on December 19, 1989 to Wayne & Brenda (Hart) Foucart.
