



## Jack Edward Griffiths

November 8, 1938 - November 1, 2015

Jack Edward Griffiths of Cadillac passed away Sunday, November 1, 2015 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. He was 76.

Jack was born November 8, 1938 in St. Charles, Michigan to Henry and Clarice (Seeley) Griffiths; even though he grew up celebrating and believing his birthday was November 7.

He attended Central Michigan University and his career in the boat industry started in St. Charles. He eventually became plant manager and a major stock holder at Four Winns in Cadillac.
