James Oliver Larson of Cadillac passed away Friday morning, March 1, 2013 at his home. He was 69. Mr. Larson was born July 8, 1943 in Detroit, Michigan to Oliver John and Edna Petrea (Dahlquist) Larson and they preceded him in death.

Mr. Larson graduated from Mackenzie High School in Detroit. He then served in the United States Army. After serving in the Army he worked at Triangle Broach Company in Detroit. Later he was a Master Electrician for IBEW (International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers) at Local 56 out of Detroit and Local 665 out of Lansing for over 30 years, retiring out of Lansing in 1999.
