James E. Schrank of Cadillac passed away Monday, July 23, 2018 at Samaritas Senior Living in Cadillac. He was 76.

Jim was born October 26, 1941 in Saginaw, Michigan to Charles H. and Jane (Bogardus) Schrank, and they preceded him in death.

Jim graduated high school from Arthur Hill in Saginaw, in 1959. He worked at the General Motors Steering Gear plant, and retired after 31 years. He was part owner of "The Hockey Shop" at Saginaw Bay Ice Arena. Along with hockey, Jim loved golf and University of Michigan sports.

He was a member of the UAW and a lifetime member of the Saginaw County Sports Hall of Fame.

On January 19, 1963 in Saginaw, Michigan he married the former Diane J.
