John Wesley McDill, Jr. of Boon died Friday, March 29, 2019 at his home. He was 84. John was born on December 3, 1934 in Levering, Michigan to John Wesley & Ella Marie (Olson) McDill and they preceded him in death.

Mr. McDill attended school in Michigan and later entered the United States Air Force and served for 4 years during the Korean War. After his service to our country he remained in New Mexico where he worked for the Alfalfa Growers Association and later moved back to Michigan and worked in the Flint area for a time. Later Mr. McDill became a Journeyman Roofer and worked for many years with various roofing companies as well as owning his own business and retired in 2002.
