Judy Hagberg of Cadillac died Friday afternoon, March 2, 2012 at her home. She was 73. She was born on May 10, 1938 in Manton to Ancel C. & Una (Gumm) Norman and they preceded her in death. Judy graduated from Manton High School in 1956 and graduated from Cadillac Institute of Cosmetology in 1975.

Mrs. Hagberg had lived all her life in this area and had been employed at Steve Fowler's Beauty Shop for over 25 years. She was a member of the Women of the Moose Lodge of Cadillac and the Daisy Chain of the Elks Lodge of Cadillac. After her husband retired they worked for the Winnebago Motor Coach Co. out of Iowa as Regional Directors and traveled all over the country.
