Julie Kay Kellison, age 61 Cadillac passed away on Tuesday, August 22, 2017 at her home after a long battle with cancer.

Julie was born in Port Huron, Michigan on November 2, 1955 to Kenneth and Dorothy Blevins. She graduated from Port Huron High School and continued on to receive her doctorate degree in Veterinary Medicine from Michigan State University on June 8, 1984.

Julie was married to Paul Kellison on March 10, 1995 for eleven years until brain cancer took his life in 2006.

Julie worked for several veterinarian clinics in Florida and Michigan including Whaley Road Veterinary Hospital in Cadillac. She led an active and inspired life culminating in establishing her own clinic "Paws and Claws Animal Wellness Center" in December of 2006. She had diverse interests including raising horses, horseback riding, quilting, reading, serving her community, especially animal shelters, and her five cats.

Her contagious laugh and courage was an inspiration to many. She was a member of Cadillac First Church of the Nazarene and the local business association.
