Keith J. Fenner of Cadillac passed away Saturday September 22, 2012 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 95. He was born July 11, 1917 in Genesee County, Michigan to Ernest A. and Celia (Walker) Fenner.

He was very proud to be a veteran after serving in the United States Army as an airplane mechanic in World War II. He worked for General Motors for 30 years until retiring. On March 30, 1946 in Owosso he married the former Edith L. Lutze. He was very active in the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Cadillac and volunteered with the Community Center of the Church well into his eighties.
