Kenneth Paul “Kenny” Eastman, Jr. of Boon, died Saturday evening, March 10, 2012 at his home. He was 71. He was born on May 11, 1940 in Flint to Kenneth Paul and Marjorie I. (Clement) Eastman, Sr.

Kenny had served 5 1/2 years in the Michigan National Guard. Mr. Eastman held a variety of jobs in his lifetime, from white collar to blue collar. He was a Salesman at Sears, General Motors factory worker, Traffic Manager for Yankee Department Stores, United States Customs Broker, farmer, sexton, gas station owner and he retired from Paulstra in 2008. He also had served as a volunteer fireman for Cedar Creek Township for 15 years and was a member of the Moose Lodge of Cadillac.
