Kristin P. Corwin, a resident of Cadillac, Michigan, passed away on January 19, 2018. She was 62.

Kris was born on February 22, 1955 in Grand Rapids, Michigan. She was one of six children born to Stanley and Doris (Van Duren) Smith.

Kris was a 1973 graduate of Cadillac High School, and spent most of her life in the Cadillac area. She was the owner of Admiral's Pet Shop, and was later employed by Wexford County as an Animal Control Assistant. She later became self-employed as an animal caregiver. She was a long-time member and active officer of the Wonderland Humane Society. She was a champion in the defense of animals and their right to loving care.

She is survived by her mother, Doris Smith; brothers, Scott Smith, Jeff (Dana) Smith; sisters, Lauren (Michael) Conway and Carole (Joseph) Moomey, as well as many nieces, nephews, and grand nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Gordon Corwin, her father, Stanley Smith and her brother, Brian Smith.
