



Lawrence Matthew "Jitterbug" Bruno

September 12, 1938 - September 10, 2013

Lawrence Matthew "Jitterbug" Bruno, of Cadillac, passed away Tuesday evening, September 10, 2013, at his home. He was 74.

He was born September 12, 1938, in Weirton, W.Va., to Tony and Anna (Sousa) Bruno, and they preceded him in death.

Mr. Bruno had lived in Manton since 1998. He was a member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac and Boilermakers Local No. 169. He was also a member of the NRA and enjoyed model trains, hunting and was a history and cowboy enthusiast.

On November 10, 2012, in Cadillac, he married the former Jeanne M. A memorial mass will be held 11 a.m. Monday, September 16, 2013, at St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac, with Monsignor Francis Murphy as celebrant.
