Lester O. Nolan of Boon passed away Friday, July 19, 2013 at The Lakeview in Cadillac. He was 80. He was born January 31, 1933 in Boon to Sylvester A. and Pearl Mae (Plotts) Nolan and they preceded him in death.

Lester attended Mesick Schools before serving in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict Era. He then married the former Gladys Pauline Millen on June 18, 1955 in Boon and she preceded him in death on September 21, 2003.
