Lewis Junior Ashbay of Manton passed away Thursday evening, July 26, 2018 at Pleasant Lake Lodge in Cadillac. He was 89. He was born on February 23, 1929 in Manton to Lewis Alexander & Carrie Christine (Cook) Ashbay.

Lewis graduated from Manton High School in 1947 and later entered the United States Army and served during the Korean Conflict. After he returned from his service to our country he attended the Toledo Meat Cutters School and had worked for various grocery stores retiring from Feldpausch Grocery Store in Eaton Rapids, Michigan.

Mr. Ashbay was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Manton for many years and had served as a trustee there. He was a member of the American legion Post of Springport, Michigan and was active in the Kwianis Club of Eaton Rapids. He enjoyed bowling, playing softball, hunting, fishing, gardening and spending time with his family.

Bowling and she survives him along with their children: Gordon (Valli) Ashbay of Grand Ledge, Gary (Ellen) Ashbay of Battle Creek and Lucinda (Michael) Rathbun of Cadillac; 8 grandchildren; 12 great grandchildren; 2 sisters: Lois Millen of Boon and Avis (Al) Price of Harrison.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a son, Warren E. Ashbay and 2 sisters: Evonne Schuietma and Dora Houvener.
