June 30, 1918 - January 19, 2019

Margaret Ann Coleman of Cadillac passed away Saturday morning, January 19, 2019 at Autumnwood of McBain. She was 100.

Margaret was born on June 30, 1918 in Lake City to Enos E. & Lulu A. (Venner) Christie.

Margaret grew up on a farm between Lake City and Falmouth and graduated from Lake City High School in 1936. On September 4, 1937 she married Lyle K. Coleman and he preceded her in death on September 10, 2003.

Mrs. Coleman had been employed at Kickaway Garments and Fashion Industries for a total of 45 years before retiring. After retiring she and her husband volunteered as drivers for the Red Cross, Probate Court, FIA (Dept. of Social Services) and also transporting cancer patients to Traverse City for their treatments. She was a faithful member of the Cadillac Church of God which is known as the Northern Light Church of Cadillac today.

Margaret had been a Boy Scouts Den Mother, 4-H Leader and was a member of the Cadillac Square Dance Club.

Survivors include her 3 of her 4 children: Keith (Elda) Coleman of McBain, Douglas (Jean) Coleman of Gulfport, Mississippi, and Sandra (Jerry) Taylor of

Bath, Michigan; 5 grandchildren: Jason Coleman, Jeffrey (Melissa) Taylor, Kimberly (Jeremy) Smelker, Carol Coleman, and Brenda (Jeff) Hamman; 8 great grandchildren, 3 great-great grandchildren. In addition to her parents and husband Margaret was preceded in death by a son, Phillip Coleman in 1963, a grandson, Jerry Coleman in 1978 and 4 brothers and 1 sister and a daughter-in-law, Udi Coleman.
