



## Marian Horton

September 18, 1919 - April 6, 2015

Marian Horton of Cadillac passed away early Monday morning, April 6, 2015 at The Lakeview in Cadillac. She was 95.

She was born on Sept. 18, 1919 in Thompsonville, Michigan to Chester W. & Hazel M. (Helfrich) Morrill and they preceded her in death. In 1979 she married Thomas K. Horton and he preceded her in death in 2001.

Mrs. Horton moved to Cadillac in the 1960's and later moved to Florida in 1976 and lived in Largo, Florida until she moved back to Cadillac in July of 2002. While living in Cadillac Marian had been employed at Roundhouse Lumber Co. in Cadillac. She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and had volunteered with the United Way of Cadillac.
